Chelmsford City Centre Re-Opened

Chelmsford City Centre re-opened from Monday, 15 June with new social distancing measures in place. These measures include a 'keep left' system for pedestrians, street markings and new directional signage. The government announced that all non-essential retailers will be allowed to reopen in England from Monday, as long as social distancing measures are implemented.

To ensure these new measures are as easy to follow as possible, vinyl floor markings will be placed along the pedestrianised footway, starting from Moulsham Street and finishing at the Shire Hall end of the High Street, including Springfield Road up to its junction with Bond Street. These markings will display a clear message to 'keep left' and will be placed on both sides of the pedestrianised footway.

Additional information will also be put in place to encourage social distancing and the two-metre rule, while reinforcing the message of "be safe, be kind and be patient". Signage will be used all around the city centre, including electronically, to ensure that the new rules are seen from car parks and before shoppers enter the main shopping areas.
