ESSEX COMMUNITY SHIELD

Essex County Council is supporting the national effort to get food and supplies to the County's most vulnerable. As well as working alongside volunteers within the village. A distribution hub has been setup by ECC and from last weekend, food packages begun being dispatched to those vulnerable residents. These including over 70s and pregnant women who have no family/friend support. Residents eligible for this will be contacted by the NHS or GP. You will then need to register with the Essex Welfare Service should you need assistance. Either via email essexwelfareservice.org or 0300 303 9988 Mon- Fri 8am to 7pm, Sat and Sun between 10am to 2 pm. or Chelmsford Council 01245 280731. If you feel you should be entitled to this but dont know how to register, one of the Good Easter Volunteers will be more than happy to assist. Our team of volunteers will be working alongside CHP, CCC and the Welfare Service to provide the best service for our village. So please dont hesitate to contact anyone of us.

LOCAL SERVICES/FOOD SUPPLY

SHOPPING: For all essential grocery shopping for anyone isolating, or struggling due to no transport. Below we have a list of local suppliers of fruit/veg. animal feed, butchers, etc. If you are able to access online or call them, they will happily make arrangements for home deliveries. If you need one of our volunteers to help get essential grocery shopping, we kindly ask if any shopping lists can be given to one of our volunteers by MONDAYS for mid week delivery and THURSDAYS for a weekend delivery. We are registered also with CHP, CCC and Welfare Service to maximise the help we can give as Good Easter Volunteers.

PERSCRIPTIONS: If you are isolating & unable to collect your perscription from Writtle. If you contact the surgery, request for it to be added to the 'Good Easter Box' and delivery will be arranged, but please feel free to contact us if any problems/questions
